Handicap / Class Racing – All club races will be run on a boat handicap basis within a single fleet. If 3 or more boats of the same class start a race, they will receive results for their class, as well as for the handicap fleet. If 3 or more junior competitors start a race, they will receive 'junior race results', as well as results within the full handicap fleet.

Race Scoring – The Low Point system will be used for scoring races in all series.

Series Scoring (Discards) -

A series of 1 race shall count 1

A series of 2 races shall count 2

A series of 3 races shall count 2

A series of 4 races shall count 3

A series of 5 or 6 races shall count 4

A series of 7 or 8 races shall count 5

A series of 9 or 10 races shall count 6

Etc.

For race results to count towards a series/regatta score, a helm must have sailed the same boat in each result. Where a class of boat has more than one size of sail, all sizes of sail will be regarded as the same boat as long as the yardstick for the largest sail is used for all.

Any class race results awarded will count towards a class series/regatta score. The number of races in the class series/regatta shall be deemed to be the number of races in which the class were awarded results.

Any junior race results awarded will count towards a junior series/regatta score. The number of races in the junior series/regatta shall be deemed to be the number of races in which junior race results were awarded.

Series ties in one day regattas — (taken from Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing) — If there is a series-score tie between two or more boats, each boat's race scores shall be listed in order of best to worst, and at the first point(s) where there is a difference the tie shall be broken in favour of the boat(s) with the best score(s). No excluded (discarded) scores shall be used. If a tie remains between two or more boats, they shall be ranked in order of their scores in the last race. Any remaining ties shall be broken by using the tied boats' scores in the next-to-last race and so on until all ties are broken. These scores shall be used even if some of them are excluded scores.

Series ties in long series – If there is a series score tie between two or more boats, each boat's race scores shall be listed in order of best to worst, and at the first point(s) where there is a difference the tie shall be broken in favour of the boat(s) with the best score(s). No excluded (discarded) scores shall be used. If a series tie remains, each boat's discarded scores from all races sailed shall be listed in order of best to worst, and at the first point where there is a difference the tie shall be broken in favour of the boat with the best score.

Championships – Club, Class and Junior Championships will be calculated from results from the following 10 long series: Early Bird, Spring Handicap, Burnswark Handicap, July Handicap, Summer Handicap, Autumn Handicap, Queensberry Handicap, Winter Cup, Vendace Handicap, Commodore's Cup; plus the following 6 club regattas: Castle Loch Shield, May Regatta, Beverage Jug, Summer Regatta, September Regatta and RNLI Regatta.

Championships scoring and discards – Overall championship results will be calculated on the allocation of the following points for each series/regatta: Winner – 1 point, second – 2 points, etc, right through the fleet, e.g. if 15 entrants take part in a series, the last placed boat will get 15 points. Where a competitor does not take part in a series/regatta, their score for that series/regatta shall be "number entries in series/regatta +1". For series/regatta results to count towards a Championship score, the helm is NOT required to sail the same boat in each series/regatta.

The same principle of discards as used within an individual series/regatta shall apply, i.e. if the club runs 15 or all 16 series/regattas, 9 scores shall count If the club runs 13 or 14 series/regattas, 8 scores shall count If the club runs 11 or 12 series/regattas, 7 scores shall count etc

The overall winner will be the person with the lowest total score.

The Chase –Fun, informal sailing challenge based on a pursuit, with the slowest boats heading off round a course first and the faster classes timed to start at intervals thereafter, resulting (hopefully) in an exciting dash for the finish line. A bring-your-own-food BBQ during/after sailing (weather permitting).

Bart's Bash (Sept 10) – Take part in a worldwide sailing event to raise money for the Andrew Simpson Sailing Foundation, and afterwards enjoy a fun sailing challenge.

Training and coaching -

- * Tuesday evening supported practice (mid-April to early September). Practice skills and have fun on the water. Safety boat cover provided.
- *Saturdays Two RYA certificated 2-day courses in May / June for new and existing members. Prior booking essential, contact training officer Richard Bryant (richardbryant16@gmail.com)
- *Sunday mornings Cadets/Novices racing from mid-September onwards.
- *Summer week One five-day RYA certificated course for new and existing members. Prior booking essential, contact training officer Richard Bryant (<u>richardbryant16@gmail.com</u>)

Race Fees – £1 per competitor per race day

Race officers – All duty officers should read the Club Standard Sailing Instructions, race and safety procedures and safety policy and must turn up for duty at least one hour before the scheduled start of the event. Race officers are also expected to bring milk and biscuits and reclaim the money from race fees.

Safety officers – Safety boats must be driven in accordance with the club Health and Safety Policy. Drivers must have RYA Powerboat Level 2 and an RYA safety boat qualification is recommended. Average Points – 'Average Points' shall be awarded to ROs and SOs for the races in which they undertake duties, where 'Average Points' is defined as: 'The competitor's average points in the series over all races including those in which the competitor did not compete but excluding those where they were RO/SO'.
